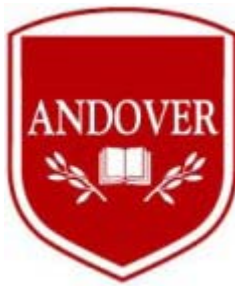

**Detailed Program Description**

*5 sessions, 2.5 hours each.*

Students will complete Andover's in-depth **Advantage College Survey** prior to starting the course. Andover's college experts will examine the survey and create a college list and note potential application strengths and weaknesses. This list will be used throughout the course to formulate ideas, to work towards a final college list, and to address application strengths and weaknesses.

Students will bring their laptops to the course to work on essays and complete online applications. All Andover locations have wireless internet access. Students may successfully take the course if they don't have laptop by bringing a notebook; their teacher will provide them with printed copies of the common application.

The goals of the course include:

1. College list. Starting with Andover's list, students will work with their college admissions instructor to explore new colleges, reevaluate prior colleges, and
2. Complete one application in full (in most cases, the common app). If the student has a laptop, he/she should bring it to every class (and use our wireless internet connection). Completion of the application should be done online.
3. Complete the main application essay.
4. Complete the standard Short Answer essay (activity essay).
5. Complete at least one "Why do you want to go here?" essay (a common essay on more competitive applications).
6. Guide students through the process of evaluating and selecting colleges.
7. Help develop application strategies to maximize their chances of admission.

**To Do** Continue working on Common App. Counselor reviews Common App. Write short answer and main essay. Edit both.

**Homework** Complete essays and Common App.

**Class 4**

**To Learn** Digging into college course catalogues. Study aboard programs. The "Why XYZ College" essay.

**To Do** Finalize strategy and college list. Write the "Why XYZ College" essay.

**Homework** Choose two colleges and bring in info for your "Why XYZ College" essay.

**To Learn:** Counselor and teacher recommendations, interviews, more on visits and colleges DI ratings.

**To Do** Write "Why XYZ College" Essay. Finalize Fall To-Do list.

No refunds are given to cancellations within 48 hours of the Andover Advantage Course or to students who are late and miss part of the Andover Advantage Course. Students may change Andover Advantage Course dates without penalty up until the business day prior to the first day of the Andover Advantage Course.

### **III. PSAT & SAT Guarantee.**

**Private tutoring students:** Andover guarantees that any student who enrolls in our full program and (1) completes all the homework in a timely fashion prior to the actual test, and (2) completes at least 18 hours of tutoring in the period 7-12 weeks prior to the actual test date will improve their SAT test score by at least 150 points for the old SAT or 250 points for the new SAT (after Jan 05). (This translates to 15/25 points on the PSAT scoring scale.) The guaranteed increase is for both math and verbal sections combined (math, verbal, and writing skills on the PSAT). The increase is measured from most recent, actual prior SAT test score to actual SAT test score for the SAT taken just after completing the private tutoring. Actual test must be taken within two weeks of last private tutoring session. (For PSAT, improvement is measured from most recent prior PSAT to PSAT taken just after the program.) When prior scores of the same test are not available, then, if taking the SAT, prior math and verbal PSAT scores will be used. If no usable prior scores are available, then first diagnostic test score (from test taken at home from an ETS-published book, proctored by ANDOVER) is used; in this case, an ANDOVER tutor will proctor the test. Students who have no prior usable scores and do not wish to take the proctored SAT at home are not eligible for the guarantee. Proctoring time will count as 2 hours of private tutoring. Students/Parents who are completing a few tutoring hours for the PSAT and most of them for the SAT may apply the guarantee to the SAT if at least 18 hours are completed within 10 weeks of the SAT. The guarantee is: if you do all the work and don't improve by at least 150/250 points, you will get four (4) free hours of tutoring. This free tutoring has no cash value. To qualify, mail to us copies of actual current and prior test scores. A counselor will check your request to verify that you completed all the assigned homework.

**Andover Advantage Course Students:** As described in our brochure, Andover guarantees that any Andover Advantage Course student who enrolls in our PSAT/SAT Andover Advantage Course and (1) completes all the homework in a timely fashion prior to the actual test, and (2) attends all hours of Andover Advantage Course lecture prior to the actual test date will improve his/her SAT test score by at least 150 points for the old SAT or 250 points for the new SAT (after Jan 05). (This translates to 15/25 points on the PSAT scoring scale.) The guaranteed increase is for both math and verbal sections combined (math, verbal, and writing skills/grammar on the PSAT and new SAT). The increase is measured from most recent actual prior SAT test score to actual SAT test score for the SAT taken just after completing the Andover Advantage Course. Actual test must be taken within six weeks of last Andover Advantage Course session. (For PSAT, improvement is measured from most recent prior PSAT to PSAT taken just after the program.) If prior scores for the SAT are not available, then prior math and verbal PSAT scores will be used. Guarantee only applies if prior actual test scores are available (i.e. scores from fake SATs cannot be used).

### **IV. Admissions.**

We reserve the right to expel students whose parents are disruptive or uncooperative. Tutoring hours are calculated in 50-minute increments and rounded up to the nearest half-hour.
